Since we are foreign bidder and we are exporting conductor from India and payment will be relished in Indian Rupee in this case as per our understanding we cannot get benefit of duty free import of raw materials i.e. aluminium and attract 8.25% custom duty considering as domestic supply.	<p>Bidders are advise to Seek Clarification regarding Taxation/Custom duties in this matter from tax consultant of India.</p> <p>However, as per our information the goods supply to Nepal/Bhutan qualify as export even the payment received in the Indian Currency i.e INR.</p> <p>Further, all taxes & duties, as applicable in India &/or Nepal under the subject project are to be ascertained by the bidders themselves. Purchaser shall bear no responsibility/liability on account of any Taxes and Duties.</p>
2.		Please also note that SAPDC will pay Inland logistic cost in NPR, being Indian Manufacturer, we don't have Bank account in Nepal. Will you not pay in Indian Rupee? Because SAPDC will pay us logistic payment only after delivered the material at site and we will pay to transporter in advance.
